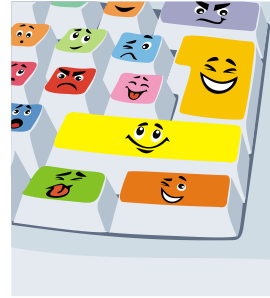

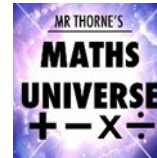
Free apps that can be used to make posters/ books about things the children have learned about.



My story app: app to help create stories, add pictures and voiceovers



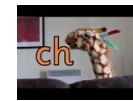

Keeping your child safe online

Make sure security settings are in place to filter out inappropriate material

Discuss simple rules for keeping safe online and making sure they understand their importance. SMART Rules

- ask permission before using the Internet and discuss what websites they are using
- only use websites you have chosen together or a child friendly search engine
- not use their real name when using games or websites on the Internet, (create a nick name)
- tell you immediately if they see anything they are unhappy
